Call for Expressions of Interest

I. Background information

In the current post-pandemic and geo-political context, the European Union is committed to remain strongly engaged in the Western Balkans. Youth issues are at the top of the agenda and efforts are made to get youth more involved in politics. In this context, the European Commission and the European Parliament are co-organising the first post-pandemic *Bridging the Gap* conference on **24-27 April 2023** in Brussels, Belgium.

II. Key objectives

- **Enable space for dialogue** continue the process of promoting dialogue between young MPs and youth activists and have a discussion on youth policy and engagement.
- Connect with the EU build cooperation between future leaders of the region, the European Parliament, the European Commission the European External Action Service and the European civil society.
- **Promote EU enlargement** contribute to the overall EU approach to youth policy in the Western Balkans and the EU-related reform process.
- ➤ Empower young policy-makers reinforce regional cooperation and encourage the creation of cross-party youth caucuses in the Parliaments.
- ➤ Envisage a common future foster confidence and reconciliation at all levels by working together on common regional objectives.

III. Key topics

Topics of the Programme are:

- Role of youth in the EU enlargement process;
- Disinformation;
- Green and digital transition;
- Regional cooperation.

Participants interested are invited to share their views and standpoints of their organisations within each specific topic.

Local transportation to/from airport to be covered by participants, while food will be covered by organizers during the entire programme.
