To design a system for monitoring the activities arising from the Strategy for Roma and to use them as a control mechanism for the quality of the implementation of the Strategy and the National Action Plans.  At least once a year to conduct analysis of general public policies that are of particular importance for the Roma communities and on the basis of them to propose to ministerial ministries ways of integrating measures that maximize the benefit of Roma communities from the general policies of the country in the areas: employment, education, housing, health, gender equality and culture.  2. In cooperation with the Ministry of Education and Science, the Ministry of Labour and Social Policy, the Ministry of Health, the Ministry of Transport and Communications, the Ministry of Local Self-Government and the Ministry of Culture in cooperation each year until September in their annual plans and programs integrate the activities of the Strategy and the National Action Plans and for their realization to foresee funds in the budget
	3. In cooperation with the Secretariat for European Affairs to develop a Plan for coordination of current and potential domestic and international donors that support the implementation of the Strategy and the National Action Plans; 4. To represent the Republic of Macedonia internationally for Roma related issues that emerge from the Strategy for Roma in the Republic of Macedonia 2014-2020

Employees in the Employment Centers are trained in the realization of all types of services (eg job search support, preparation of individual plans for hardworking people, information, mediation in employment, motivation, etc.), as well as information, counseling, activation and assistance for successful inclusion and participation of all unemployed persons in active employment programs and measures.

The Employment Agency of the Republic of Macedonia implemented active programs and measures for employment in accordance with the Operational Plan for Active Programs and Measures and Services on the Labor Market for 2016. In 2016, a total of 405 unemployed Roma people applied for participation in the active programs and measures, 153 women (37.78%) and 199 young people aged up to 29 years (49.13%). 112 unemployed persons were successfully engaged in various active for employment measures, 48 of whom were women (42.86%) and 71 young people aged up to 29 years (63.39%). In 2016, in the employment services (Job Search Assistance, Motivational Training, Preparation for Employment and Work, Professional Orientation and Career Counseling and Education on the Use of Online Services of ESA, a total of 9127 Roma unemployed persons were included, 3475 women (38.07%) and 2605 young people up to 29 years of age (28.54%). The services for activating individuals at risk of social exclusion, aimed at increasing the access and participation of people at risk of social exclusion to employment programs and measures, a total of 746 Roma were activated.

The financial means for implementing the active employment programs, measures and services for the unemployed Roma people are included in the total funds for the realization of the active programs and measures and services on the labor market that are realized with all other target groups of unemployed persons.

In the framework of Services for activating individuals at risk of social exclusion, 746 Roma were activated, out of which 425 persons were analyzed by the mentors for their employment capacities. 110 persons of the total covered persons with these services were included in some of the active programs and employment measures implemented by the ESA.

Also, information on the possibilities for using the active measures and services for employment, information on the labor market and employment opportunities, the unemployed Roma people were also part of the Job Search Assistance services, Motivational Training, Professional Orientation and Career Counseling, Training for using the ESA on-line servoces, which included 9110 unemployed Roma, of whom 3466 (38.05%) were women and 2588 (28.41%) were young people up to 29 years of age. The Employment Centers through their representatives (employees of the Centers) regularly cooperated by providing providing information and advice to the unemployed Roma and employers, information on the active labor market programs and measures, the labor market and services provided by the EARM, as well as for other information and activities in the field of employment.
