As of 2017, 16 buildings are constructed with 731 apartments.

How to use social housing:

The number of distributed apartments as of 2017 is 669 social apartments in 14 buildings-residential buildings, for which the contracts lease the apartment for 5 years. The apartments are with an area of 35,00 m2 to 45,00 m2, and the rent per square meter is 15,00 MKD.

Upon completion of the lease of 5 years, the assets of the tenants are audited, i.e. evidence of acquired real estate, apartment / house is required. If the person has not acquired a real estate apartment / house, the same person signs a new lease agreement for 5 years use.

Target Roma:

Roma are applying in all 7 categories of the socially vulnerable groups, determined by the Decision on allocation of these apartments, adopted by the Government of the Republic of Macedonia. According to this decision, the Roma population is explicitly targeted.

As of 2016, out of the 678 social housing units built, after the announced call for a public call for the total 669 social housing distributed, 118 social apartments were allocated to Roma from all categories of socially vulnerable groups for which they applied.
