

Anti-discrimination workshop

- What is antiziganism and racism?
- Is it fear, phobia, racism or something deeper and more destructive?
- It is unfiltered by the majority society as phenomenon which distinguish and discriminate the others "individuals or groups" which are not majority population, in the case Roma, on race origin.

Anti-discrimination workshop

- The right to non-discrimination is recognised inter alia by the main international instruments, but still Roma are excluded from all ongoing processes.
- This requires political will and taking the good arguments about public policy interest from the capitals to the local authorities.

Anti-discrimination workshop

The right to non-discrimination is guarantied with separate laws because Macedonia do not have comprehensive anti-discrimination law, but we have provisions in:

- Macedonian Constitution
- Law on equal opportunities for man and woman
- Criminal code
