




Census recommendations 2010



- Core and non-core topics
- * Objectives:
 - Provide guidance and assistance to countries
 - Facilitate and improve comparability of data

Ethno-cultural characteristics: ethnicity, language, religion



- increasingly important in context of migration, integration and minority policies
- non-core topics
- subjective and sensitive topic –free and open declaration of the respondents is essential
- appropriate data protection and disclosure control
- consult representatives in the drafting of questions, definitions and conduct of the census

Definition



« Ethnicity is based on a shared understanding of the history and territorial origins of an ethnic group or community as well as on particular cultural characteristics: language, religion, customs and ways of life »

Recommendations (1/2)



- affiliation with ethnic groups is distinct from language and/or religion
- Should not be confused with citizenship
 - → Better to use « ethnicity » and avoid « nationality »
- * free self-declaration / open question
- respondents can indicate more than one ethnic affiliation

Recommendations (2/2)



- "none" or 'not declared' is allowed
- provide instructions on determining ethnicity of children from mixed couples
- document the basic criteria and classification procedures
- classification depends on national concepts – no international recommendation

Challenges



- Often considered a sensitive topic
- Subjective self identification
- Complex
 - Inter-marriage between ethnic groups
 - Migration
 - Community attitudes
- Data quality
- Developing an unambiguous question



Overcoming challenges





Overcoming challenges



- data protection and disclosure control
- test questions carefully
- * well-trained enumerators
- disseminate and communicate the statistics
- fundamental principles of official statistics




