# EU SILC – European Union Statistics on Income and Living Conditions

- Key tool for harmonized survey on **poverty and social exclusion**
- **Laeken indicators** – 21 indicators
- Advantages
  - possibility to compare EU member countries
  - regular survey/yearly
- Disadvantages
  - impossibility to identify specifics at the national level related to poverty and social exclusion → **national indicators of poverty and social exclusion**

# Project

## National indicators of poverty and social exclusion and proposal for the way of their regular monitoring

### Results:

- **32 national indicators**
- 4 indicators – residents of segregated Roma settlements

# Process of national indicators elaboration

- Expert group from various fields of research (sociology, statistics, human geography, social work, expert from Roma population)
  - Regular project meetings
  - Four-days sessions
  - Discussion with invited experts from practice with experience with specific problems (legislation, statistics, policy, NGO)
  - Consulting with the recipient organisation

# Elaboration of indicators - background

- Analysis of legislation
- Analysis of statistical surveys
- Analysis of good practices of creation and implementation of national specific indicators on poverty and social exclusion in different EU countries
- Elaboration – reflecting priorities set in the Slovak National Action Plan on social inclusion
- Target groups threatened with poverty
- Accessibility of data

# Outcome:

- Proposal of **40** indicators
- Pilot research
  - Laeken indicators
  - Measurement - values based on existing data
  - Suggestion of new questions
- Final number of indicators: **32**

<b>Indicator 11</b>	<b>Enrollment rate of children from Roma segregated settlements in pre-school education</b>  <b>(Miera zaškolenosti detí zo segregovaných osád v predškolských zariadeniach)</b>
<b>Definition</b>	Share of children in age 3-5 from segregated settlements integrated in pre-school education in total number of children in age 3-5 from segregated settlements
<b>Source</b>	UNDP (Survey on living conditions of Roma households 2006)
<b>Goal</b>	Roma children poverty elimination
<b>Target group</b>	Children

- Question proposal:

1. Is your child attending a pre-school facility?
2. If not, state the reason
  - a) Absence of facility in the place of living
  - b) The nearest facility is too far
  - c) High expences
  - d) No need for pre-school education
  - e) Other

<b>Indicator 19</b>	<b>Ratio of segregated Roma settlements to all Roma settlements</b> <b>(Podiel segregovaných rómskych osídlení na všetkých rómskych osídleniach)</b>
Definition	Share of segregated Roma settlements located out of community in total number of Roma settlements
Source	Atlas of Roma communities
Goal	Elimination of poverty and social exclusion of the most threatened marginal groups of people
Target group	Segregated Roma communities

<b>Indicator 20</b>	<b>Share of Roma population living in segregated Roma settlements</b> <b>(Podiel obyvateľov žijúcich v segregovaných rómskych osídleniach)</b>
Definition	Share of population living in segregated Roma settlements located out of community in total number of population living in Roma settlements
Source	Atlas of Roma communities
Goal	Elimination of poverty and social exclusion of the most threatened marginal groups of people
Target group	Segregated Roma communities

<b>Indicator 22</b>	<b>Rate of extreme exclusion in segregated Roma settlements</b> <b>(Miera extrémneho vylúčenia segregovaných rómskych osídlení)</b>
<b>Definition</b>	Share of segregated Roma settlements with absence of at least 3 elementary infrastructure items (electricity, gass, access road, sewage, water spply, streetlights, etc.) in total number of segregated Roma settlements
<b>Source</b>	Atlas of Roma communities
<b>Goal</b>	Accessibility of housing and infrastructure of the most threatened groups of population
<b>Target group</b>	Segregated Roma communities
