GOAL GROUPS

rural, socially excluded Roma communities and medically disadvantaged at risk of poverty

GOAL OF THE PROJECT

To reduct poverty, social inequalities and elimination in chosen Roma communities of Vranov nad Topl'ou region through the participation in the eco-farming works targeted at bioseed production

OBJECTIVES OF THE PROJECT

- creating opportunities for farm activities of people who suffer from hunger, malnutrition and poor health
- support the creation of jobs for long term unemployed within biowastecomposting and gardening activities
- cultivation and environmental remediation of disturbed industrial activity
- mitigation, or possibly preventing intolerance and ethnic conflict Roma, non-Roma majority
- environmental education, training, implementation and Educational-training activities and social fieldwork.

ACTIVITIES

- production of bioseeds
- community-supported organic gardening
- water management measures

PRODUCTION OF BIOSEEDS AT ECOFARM

- a chain of activities from harvesting to its processing and drying
- focus along side vegetables on selected medicinal and aromatic plants (marigold, thyme, mint, chamomile chamomile, lovage, lemonbalm)







COMMUNITY-SUPPORTED ORGANIC GARDENING

to promote food self-sufficiency of poor families who are concerned about hunger



WATER MANAGEMET MEASURES

retention tank will be connected to the already established system of channels, allowing for the capture of surface water and rainwater for ecofarm managed lands. Collected water will be a priority to serve in periods of drought in irrigated areas

production of brooms
